The Canadian Cashmere Producers Association invites cashmere producers to participate in the Canadian Cashmere Fleece Competition, on September 22, 2018. The Judge

Jayne Deardorff owns and operates ME 2 Custom Fiber Processing FARM in Colville, Washington. Together with her husband Daryl, they have a farm where they raise cattle, sheep, Cashmere goats, grain and hay.

In 2013 Jayne graduated from Olds College with her Master Spinning degree. She is now an instructor for this program. Jayne has also taught several classes in spinning Cashmere fibers, becoming a fiber judge, and how to use different spinning equipment.

Jayne has been a fiber and animal judge at several events including, Canada Cashmere fiber show at Olds College, Western Cashmere association show at Oregon Flock and Fiber Festival, Eastern Cashmere association show in Vermont, along with several local fairs and fiber events.

Working with fiber and blending different fibers together is what Jayne really enjoys.

The Classes

Fleeces are from this year's harvest; they are raw, meaning that they are unwashed and do include Guard Hairs. On the other hand, the judge will appreciate assessing fleeces without VM and poop.

Fleeces will be judged by class, with 1st to 4th place ribbons in each class and rosettes awarded to Champions and Reserve Champions for Junior Does (1st-3rd fleeces) and Senior Does (4th fleeces and over), Junior Bucks (1st-3rd fleeces), and Senior Bucks (4th fleeces and over), and one in the Wether class, and finally Best In Show.
